

Leisure Card Application Procedure

As of September 4th, 2018 a LEISURE CARD is required for all individuals to register and participate in the programs and activities offered at the Memorial Regional Civic Centre.

The leisure card can be obtained at the Memorial Regional Civic Centre customer service desk, **starting Monday, September 10**, according to the following schedule:

- Monday to Thursday 9 to 11 a.m. and 1 to 3 p.m.
- Tuesday 5:30 to 7:30 p.m.
- Additional hours from September 10 to September 20 Monday to Thursday 4 to 7:30 p.m.

WHAT IS REQUIRED:

- The Application form duly filled out
- A proof of identity and two proofs of residency with name and address, per applicant (See: Acceptable Proof of Identity and Residency document)
- Without above documents, the request won't be processed
- A picture will be taken for the leisure card all applicants have to be present at registration

DEFINITIONS:

RESIDENT – Resides within Campbellton city limits

NON-RESIDENT — Resides outside of Campbellton city limits and within/in regional boundaries listed below PARTNER — Resides within Tide Head or Dalhousie municipality limits

<u>VISITOR</u> – Resides outside of Campbellton city limits and outside of the following regional boundaries: Robinsonville NB (West), Charlo NB (East), Matapédia QC (West), Nouvelle QC (East) Leisure card required for <u>programs</u> only - see chart: **WHEN IS THE LEISURE CARD REQUIRED?** – verso

LEISURE CARD VALIDITY PERIOD:

September 1st to June 30th

(Valid until August 31st if Centre remains open during the summer – 2 months bonus)

The Memorial Regional Civic Centre reserves the right to verify leisure cards. Users must have their leisure card with them at all times when using the Civic Centre.

2018-2019 SEASON LEISURE CARD COST:

Resident – No cost (included in property tax payment)

Non-Resident and Visitor* - \$200 (plus tax) (* See chart: When is the Leisure CARD REQUIRED — verso)

Partner – No cost (Tide Head – included in their yearly contribution / Dalhousie – service exchange)

Family of 4 (Parent(s)- Children less than 18) - \$700 (plus tax) (each additional child - \$100 plus tax)

Child less than 2 years old – No cost (has to be accompanied by an adult with a leisure card)

(\$5 tax included for lost or stolen card replacement or for duplicate – for all above)

ADMISSIONS/REGISTRATION COSTS:

As per Rate Schedules in place at the Memorial Regional Civic Centre.

Same for all (Residents, Non-residents (with or without an agreement), Partners and Visitors).

MUNICIPALITIES SIGNATORIES OF A LEISURE AGREEMENT:

Municipalities have an option to enter into an Agreement with the City of Campbellton and cover the cost of the leisure card for their residents. Campbellton will invoice those municipalities monthly for the full amount. You can verify with your municipality if they have elected to enter into such an agreement.

THE LEISURE-CARD IS NOT REQUIRED BY ALL (RESIDENT, NON-RESIDENT WITH/WITHOUT AN AGREEMENT, PARTNER, VISITOR) FOR:

• Admissions to events

(Tigers' games, Promotion Plus, Concerts, Shows, etc.)

Rentals (unsubsidized)

(Ice rentals, pool rentals, convention centre, birthday parties, etc.)

Tournaments and competitions

(Hockey, swimming, etc.)

- Dance schools, YMCA, judo, etc.
- Admission to facility

(Watching kids practicing or playing hockey, bar, etc.)
