SPECIFICATIONS

Two TYPES OF WOOD BURNING APPLIANCES are allowed:

- MANUFACTURED: a manufactured, CSA approved, non-combustible, enclosed container, designed to hold a small fire, the size of which does not exceed 1m in any direction and which is equipped with a spark arrestor with openings no larger than 12mm x 12mm.
- HAND-MADE: a handmade, non-combustible, enclosed container which may include some or all of the components of an outdoor fireplace and has been approved by the municipality. The appliance must be COVERED with a suitable steel wire mesh with openings no larger than 12mm x12mm.

GUIDELINES

- The appliance must be INSTALLED ON A NON-COMBUSTIBLE SURFACE. It cannot be installed on a wooden deck or other combustible platform.
- 2. The appliance must **BE INSTALLED**:
 - 3m (10ft) from any mainbuilding
 - 6m (20ft) from a neighboringhouse
 - 2m (6ft) from any accessory building or structure
 - 3m (10ft) from any hedge, tree, overhead wiring or any other combustible material

SAFETY MEASURES

1. **Follow MANUFACTURER'S INSTRUCTIONS** for the safe installation and operation of the appliance.

- The appliance shall not be used when the Department of Natural Resources has placed a BAN ON OPEN BURNING in the area; call 1-866-458-8080 for burning information.
- 3. Only **ONE APPLIANCE** shall be used on a property **AT ONE TIME**.
- An operable GARDEN HOSE or PORTABLE FIRE EXTINGUISHER must be readily available.
- 5. Always have **AN ADULT** overseeing the fire.
- 6. **ALWAYS EXTINGUISH** and never leave an appliance fire unattended.

CONTROLLING SMOKE

Only **DRY FIREWOOD** must be burned. **DO NOT BURN** pressure treated wood, painted wood, leaves, grass, other vegetation, any plastic material, food or any material that produces an unreasonable amount of smoke or other respiratory irritants.

The appliance shall **NOT BE USED IF CAUSING UNDUE HARM TO NEIGHBORS.** Several people suffer from allergies and respiratory problems. It is important to keep smoke at a minimum. Smoke enters homes through air exchangers and open windows. **BE COURTEOUS** while using your outdoor wood burning appliance.

INFRACTIONS

People not following outdoor wood burning appliances rules are subject to a fine up to \$500 under bylaw S-5 - A Bylaw Respecting Fire Prevention for the City of Campbellton.
